### **Course Description:**

- This course provides the mandatory training required to take the unarmed security guard licensing test administered by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET). Basic private security knowledge and procedures are taught.
- No certification is earned, but the certificate of completion will allow the participant to sit for the
  licensing test. This test can be administered at an Approved testing location. CLEET gives licensing
  tests each month in Tulsa and Oklahoma City. A specific list of testing times and locations are
  provided during the training. Meridian host the exam on Mondays at 6:30pm.

## **Unarmed Security Guard Licensure (from CLEET)**

- Test: Unarmed Security Guard (Phase 1 & 2),
- 70 % cumulative score satisfies CLEET certification requirements
- Candidates may take an exam three times
- Candidate must wait three business days between attempts (we suggest 2 weeks to study)
- Results will be forwarded to CLEET; however, candidates must still apply to CLEET for licensure

Fees: \$35 per exam, \$91 application fee

**Documentation required:** Certification of completion from training program and valid, current photo ID issued by a US ort US tribal government entity. Candidate must know his/her social security number or present a social security card.

Prerequisites: None

- CLEET requires 100% attendance and scores of 85% or greater on every examination.
