Frequently Asked Questions

When can adult students enroll?

The following deadlines apply to the enrollment process for completed applications. We will open the online application on November 1.

Spring Deadlines (space available basis only):

January Application Deadline	Dec. 7, 2018
January Application Status Notification Mailed	Dec. 11, 2018

What are the steps needed for enrollment?

1. To begin the enrollment process, please submit an application online on the Apply Now page of our website. The online application period begins November 1, 2018. We have computers available at the Career Planning Center if you do not have access to the Internet.

2. Apply online for Financial Aid.
3. Submit high school transcript showing date of graduation **or** GED Score Report.
4. Take academic assessment, if needed. Contact a career counselor to schedule a test day. Testing begins at 9:00 AM. There is no charge for the academic assessment.
 - Thursday, November 15, 2018 2:00 PM
 - Tuesday, December 4, 2018 8:30 AM
5. If you are exempt from the academic assessment, you must provide us with documentation before your application can be considered. You can be exempt if you have taken college level English and math, have an ACT score of 19 or higher, or if you have taken an academic assessment within the last five years. Documentation may include your college transcript(s) or alternate assessment scores such as Compass, ACT, WorkKeys, Workers Comp or Voc Rehab.
6. Attend an orientation session. You do not have to sign up, but you do need to check in at the CPC
 - Tuesday, November 13, 2018 9:00 AM
 - Thursday, November 29, 2018 9:00 AM
7. Notification of application status – accepted, on waiting list or not accepted. Once all steps have been complete, your application will be considered. You will be notified by the dates listed above.
8. **Once you have been accepted to a program**, you must complete an enrollment form and pay a \$100 deposit. The deposit is not refundable. It is applied to your last tuition payment.

When do classes begin?

Spring Semester - Classes begin on January 7, 2019.

What are the class times?

The morning class is 7:50 AM – 10:40 AM, Monday through Friday.

The afternoon class is 12:45 PM – 3:35 PM, Monday through Friday.

How much do the classes cost?

Please see the career major description for total hours. The cost is generally \$3.00 per hour.

How much are books?

Books and online curriculum will be available in the classroom for adult students.

Do all programs follow the same process?
