

Practical Nursing Required Medical Math Class Information

Individuals who apply to the Practical Nursing program will be required to show competency in basic medical math, unless they can show proof of a score of 19 or higher on the math section of the ACT19 or higher or HESI A2 Math Score is 80% or higher.

There are three ways in which this competency can be achieved.

1. Score 77% on challenge exams for the following areas:

Math Basics

(addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of whole numbers)

Fractions/Decimals/Percent

(addition, subtraction, multiplication and division using fractions, decimals and percent)

Conversions

(process of changing from one system of measurement to another in math equations)

Dosage Calculations

(use of formulas to complete math calculations for preparing the correct dose of medications)

Challenge exams may only be taken one time for each area. The cost of each challenge exam is \$10.00. Those interested may call 405/377-3333 extension 324 to set up an appointment.

2. Complete the medical math course by enrolling in the medical math section needed through the Short Term Medical Basics class offered at Meridian Technology Center.

Proof of successful completion (“C” or higher) must be submitted with your application by the deadline.
